According to Danish legislation, reviewers must not in any way be suspected of being biased in relation to the application.

You will have to consider yourself disqualified if:

- You have a specific personal or financial interest in the outcome of the matter,
- You have recently (within 5 years) worked closely or written joint publications with the applicant or a member of the research group,
- You have a close friendship or a strong animosity towards the applicant or a member of the research group,
- Any other condition known to you can cast doubt on your impartiality.

Also, we would like to inform you that the applicant will receive a copy of the evaluation form and will be given the opportunity to comment on the evaluation. In addition, reviewers can not expect to remain anonymous, as applicants have legislative right to obtain insight into matters related to their application.
